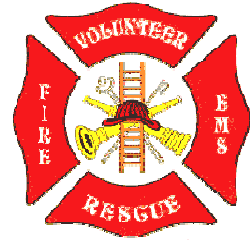


Geyserville Volunteer Firefighters' Association

The Members of the Geyserville Volunteer Firefighters' Association (GVFA) would like to extend our best wishes to you and your family this holiday season. This season also brings our annual donation request. Funds generated by this request, along with those generated by our annual summer dinner-dance and Fall Colors' pancake breakfast, are used to improve our ability to provide emergency services to the community.

You received this letter because our records indicate that you either have donated to our organization, own property and/or live in the Geyserville Fire Protection District (GFPD).

The GVFA is comprised of the volunteer firefighters of the GFPD. The District is a government entity funded via a small portion of your property taxes. Unlike other fire districts in Sonoma County, a fire assessment tax has never been imposed. This is due to your continued support of the GVFA, volunteer fire fighter staffing and prudent fiscal management.

The GVFA's operating funds are generated largely by donations and our fund raising activities throughout the year.

We are pleased to provide you with the following update of activities and progress of the GFPD during the past year:

- The Geyserville volunteer firefighters responded to 616 emergencies during 2008.
- The GVFA purchased a new rescue squad for the Geyserville Fire Protection District
- In May we held another annual Open House at Fire Station #1.
- The 2009 Dinner Dance was a tremendous success even with the smaller turn out as in years past.
- Five new firefighters joined our ranks. They completed a rigorous 130 hour recruit academy and passed an additional six month probationary period.

Your generous donation, large or small, will help the GVFA meet its' future goals which include:

- Assisting with further debt reduction of the Fire Station #1
- Recruitment and retention efforts of fire fighters
