- 2. PUBLIC DISCUSSION: The public is welcomed and encouraged to address the Board at this time on matters not on the Agenda. Please be advised that pursuant to Government Code Section 54954.2, the Board is not permitted to take action on any matter not on the Agenda unless it determines that an emergency exists or the need to take action arose after the posting of the Agenda. This period will be limited to thirty minutes and individual speakers will be limited to five minutes.

#### 3. OLD BUSINESS:

- a. Resolution 22/23-0915-01: Adopt Resolution 22/23-0915-01, proclaiming a state of emergency exists due to COVID-19 and authorizing remote teleconference (Zoom) meetings of the District for the next 30 days pursuant to California Assembly Bill 361.
- b. Fire Station Updates and Discussion: Station designs and updates for current/future Chalk Hill, Knights Valley and Alexander Valley fire stations.
- c. Knights Valley Firehouse Lease: Update on Knights Valley Spencer Lane firehouse lease execution.

  - a. For the 1,000 GPM, I will propose to do Option A where the fire district pays the full amount (\$396,909.58) upon signing contract.
  - b. For the 500 GPM, I propose to do Option A BUT we use the lease purchase option paying \$100,000 to the lender and then \$50,000-\$75,000 each year until paid off.
