## **Forestry Technician 2**

\$25.00 per hour; Final Filing Date: Continuous

<u>Position Description</u>: The Forestry Technician 2 (FT2) position is a part-time position. The FT2 is an experienced crew member responsible for operating power and hand tools to limb up trees; remove small trees, bushes and other vegetation; move cut vegetation to a chipper and feed vegetation into the chipper. This position may also involve participation in pile and broadcast burning. The work schedule is 10-hour days, 2-3 days per week.

<u>Minimum Qualifications</u>: Must be at least 18 years old at the time of employment, valid California Class C driver's license or higher, and high school diploma or equivalent. At least three months of full-time equivalent experience as a fuels crew member or similar position.

<u>Highly Desirable Qualifications</u>: Forestry or natural resources education and/or related experience. Experience as a volunteer, part-time, and/or full-time at the fire fighter or higher rank. Wildland fire ecology, use, and management experience and education, including understanding wildland fuel loading, wildland fire effects, and wildland fire monitoring. Other desirable qualifications include S-130, S-190, ICS-100, L-180, and IS-700.

Applications will be accepted via email, mail or hand delivery. Be prepared to bring your driver's license and a copy of your high school diploma, or equivalent, to your oral interview. Late, incomplete, or faxed applications will not be considered. Failure to comply with the process and appropriate requirements will result in rejection of your application. The selection process will include one or more of the following components: application review, oral interview, and background investigation.

<u>Physical Requirements</u>: This position requires frequent lifting and/or moving of heavy objects. Strength, stamina, and agility are necessary to hike steep, uneven terrain while carrying equipment. Work is performed primarily in wildland settings in all weather conditions.
